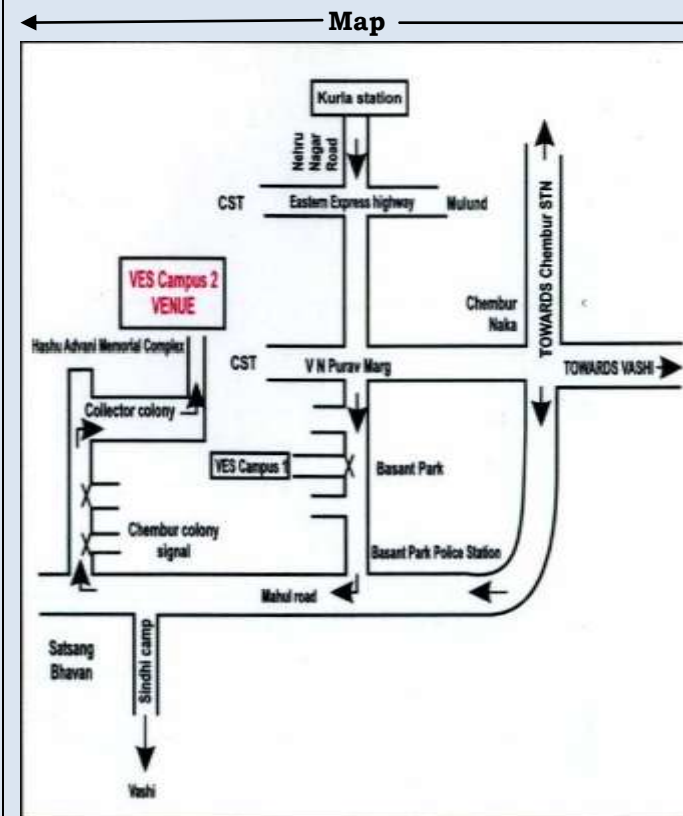

Author Name(s): Last name followed by initials, presenting author, to be underlined, Font: Times New Roman, 10 points, Line spacing 1 with 0 point before and after paragraph

Affiliation(s): Institution address, Font: Times New Roman, 10 points, Line spacing 1 with 0 point before and after paragraph.

Email of the presenting author is compulsory,

Font: Times New Roman, 10 points

Key words: Not more than 5 words

Font: Times New Roman, 10 points

Body Text: IN TWO COLUMNS with equal column width (3") and column spacing (0.5"), Font: Times New Roman, 10 points, Line spacing 1 with 0 point before and after paragraph

Subheadings: Font: All Capital, Bold, Font: Times New Roman, 10 points

Abstract Contents: Title paper, Authors' names, Affiliations, Email address, Keywords, Introduction, Objective, Experimental methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, References and Acknowledgements

Abstract length: Not more than one A4 size page
